

Open access policy

The University of Bifröst has set the policy that as many people as possible can enjoy the products of the scientific work carried out by the academic staff at the school. In order for this to happen, the school's academic staff agree to strive to publish their academic articles in open access, either through journals published in open access or through archive storage. In addition, every academic employee authorizes the university to make scientific articles written by him available and save them in open databases such as Opin vísindi (opinvisindi.is), which is a special repository of Icelandic university libraries for such articles. This applies to all scientific articles written by the employee, alone or with several authors, at the time he is employed at the University of Bifröst

Excluded are books, teaching materials, reports, opinions or material other than scientific articles published in scientific journals.

The rector or a competent representative of the rector will exclude individual scientific articles from the agreement, or delay their publication for a certain period, if the relevant employee so requests in writing.

Each academic staff member delivers, free of charge, an electronic version of the author's final version of their articles, no later than the publication date, to the school's library in an appropriate format (such as PDF) in accordance with the library's guidelines.

The school library can make the article public in an open access electronic database. The rector decides on disputes that may arise.
